Frequently Asked questions (FAQs)

Open Book Examination and Assignment Based Evaluation (Internal Assessment) for the Annual/Semester Examination-2020

1. What is the difference between Open Book Examination (OBE) and Assignment Based Evaluation (ABE, Internal Assessment)?

Ans. The Open Book Examination is meant for III year/IV Semester students of UG and PG Courses of NCWEB whereas the Assignment Based Evaluation ABE (Internal Assessment) is meant for II-year students of UG Courses and II semester PG Courses of NCWEB students.

2. What about III-year Ex.(failed) NCWEB students?

Ans. The III-year Ex. (Failed) NCWEB students have to appear in the OBE with all their Essential Repeat (if any).

3. What about I year Ex. (failed) and II-year Ex. (failed) students of NCWEB.

Ans. The I year Ex. (failed) and II-year Ex. (failed) students of NCWEB have to appear in the OBE. The dates of examination have been published in the Date sheet.

4. What about Essential Repeat (ER)/ Improvement Papers related to Part-1, Part-2 and Part 3 of 3rd year students.

Ans. Any Essential Repeat (ER)/ Improvement Papers related to Part-1, Part- 2 and Part 3 of III-year students (if any) has to be given by the Open Book Examination. The date of examination has been published in the Date sheet.

5. Which type of exam will be given by II-year students of NCWEB?

Ans. The II-year students will give Assignment Based Evaluation (ABE). For this purpose, assignment questions will be uploaded shortly which will be answered by the students writing it down on A4 size paper and uploaded. The schedule has been published on the NCWEB website. Log in Id will be provided to II-year students in some time.

6. What about students with ER (Essential Repeat) (if any) studying in II year.

Ans. The students will have to give only Assignment Based Evaluation (ABE) whereas their I year ER papers will carry forward to next year. They will give the ER papers later in the year.

7. What about students who have submitted their exam fee for II year after a gap of one/two year.

Ans. Such students will be treated at par with present II-year students and they will give Assignment Based Evaluation (ABE).

8. What about I or II-year Ex (failed) students who have submitted their Examination fee after a gap of one/two year.

Ans. They will appear in Open Book Examination. Their exam will be conducted as per the published Date sheet.

9. Incase a student does not have a smart phone/laptop/internet facility, how will she take OBE?

Ans. The student can beforehand inform its College Centre to provide ICT based infrastructure facility for examination if required. If required, facility of Common Service Centres can be availed (details will be uploaded on the DU website).

10. Does one require the internet all the time when giving Open Book Examination?

Ans. No. Internet connection will be required only for downloading the question paper and later uploading the answer sheets.
